



Briefcase Book Report

Our next book report will be a mystery book.

The book report will be assembled to look like a briefcase. Each student will receive a large sheet of brown construction paper to make their briefcase. The sheet will be folded in half and you will need to add two paper handles on the top to make it resemble a briefcase.

On the front of the briefcase write the title of the book and the author. Open it to lie flat. On the top half, illustrate four to five of the main events of the book and write a clue next to each one. This will go on the top.

Below the fold, write a brief book summary that concludes with a teaser, leaving the reader wondering how the book ends. This will be glued to the bottom half (below the fold) under the four or five pictures. You will need to place your name on your briefcase also.
