Christ the King Enrichment Program

The Christ the King After-School Enrichment Program will provide a variety of intramural and enrichment activities that students can sign up for at an additional cost. Most classes will be an hour in length beginning at 3:30 p.m. Class selections include a variety of activities such as ballet, art, drama, gymnastics, chess, music and more. A summary of the classes offered are included in the booklet.

To enroll in an enrichment class, you must complete the enclosed registration form and return it to the school office before the registration deadline.

Enrollment is on a first-come basis.

Policies and Procedures

All policies and procedures expressed in the Christ the King Student Handbook apply to the After-School Enrichment Program. Any questions should be directed to the program director.

Holidays and Inclement Weather

The program will not be available on school holidays or days that the school is closed due to hazardous weather conditions.

Pick-Up Authorization

Only authorized adults designated on the registration form will be allowed to pick up children from the program. If someone other than those listed is to pick up a child, a written note signed by the parent must be given to the program director. The parent or authorized adult to whom the child is being released must sign the child's time sheet and record the time.

Late Pick-Up Policy

For safety and security reasons, any child left at school beyond the class time will be taken to after-school care, and parents will be billed accordingly.

Refunds

If a request for withdrawal from a class is received prior to the registration deadline, you will be fully refunded. If a request for withdrawal is received after the registration deadline, you will not be refunded.
